To The Secretary Of State of the State Of Idaho,  
The undersigned, a majority of whom are citizens of the United States, desiring to form a non-profit Corporation under the Non-Profit Corporation Law of Idaho, do hereby certify:

Article I.

1. The name of the Corporation shall be National Wildlife Awareness Non-Profit Corporation.

Article II.

2. The place in this state where the principal office of the Corporation is to be located is in the city of Rexburg, Madison, County.

Article III.

1. Said Corporation is organized exclusively for educational purposes, including for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Article IV.

1. The registered agent of the Corporation is said, Rena J. Edlefsen, located at 1206 East 10,000 South, Rexburg, Idaho. 83440.

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## Article V.

1. The names and addresses of the persons who are the initial board of directors are as follows:

## Article VI.

1. The name and address of the sole incorporator is Rena J. Edlefsen, residing at 1206 East 10,000 South, Rexburg, Idaho. 83440.

## Article VII.

1. All future reports shall be mailed to 1206 East 10,000 South, Rexburg, Idaho. 83440.

## Article VIII.

1. The Corporation will not be composed of voting members.

## Article IX.

1. No director, officer, or employee of the Corporation shall as such, be liable on its debts or obligations and no director, officer, employee, or volunteer shall be personally liable as such, for any claim based upon as act or omission of such person performed in the discharge of such persons' duties except (1) for any breach of the duty of loyalty to the Corporation, (2) for acts or omissions not in good faith or which involve intentional misconduct or knowing violation of the law, or (3) for any transactions from which such person derive an improper personal benefit.

## Article X.

1. No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Third hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a Corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, This Corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this Corporation.

#### Article XI.

1. Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not to be disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

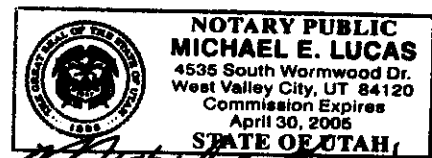
