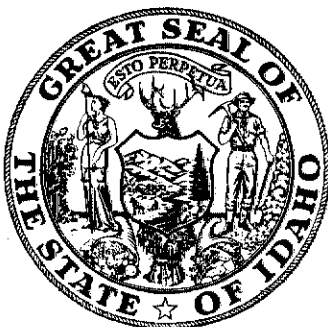

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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
WOOD RIVER FINISHES, INC.

We, the undersigned, natural persons of the age of twenty-one or more, acting as incorporators of a corporation, under the Idaho Business Corporation Act, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation.

FIRST: The name of the corporation is: Wood River Finishes, Inc.

SECOND: The period of its duration is perpetual.

THIRD: The purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

(a) To provide the general public with a painting and carpentry service.

(b) To build or otherwise acquire, to operate, and to lease, mortgage, sell, or otherwise dispose of equipment of every kind and character whatsoever, or other interests in connection, therewith.

(c) To acquire, build, purchase, hold or operate and to lease, sell or otherwise dispose of homes, factories, plants, refineries, foundries, machine shops or other manufacturing plants or establishments of every kind and character, whatsoever;

or other interests in connection, therewith..

(d) To do any and all acts in line of its business, which it may deem proper and carry on in any similar business which may be capable of being profitably carried on in connection with this company's business; or to carry on any similar business that is adapted, directly or indirectly, to add to the value of the company's property and to profits of its authorized business.

(e) To acquire, bring together, hold, dispose of, and deal in royalty and other interests in oil, gas, and minerals, and to manage, control, and exploit said interests, and to collect revenue arising therefrom.

(f) To acquire, conduct, manage, operate, and control any other corporation, co-partnership, or association of which bonds or securities, or evidences of indebtedness are held by this corporation whether the same be in the State of Idaho or elsewhere.

(g) To acquire the goodwill rights of property, and to undertake the whole or any part of the assets and liabilities of any person, firm, association or corporation, to pay for the same in cash, by stock in this corporation, its bonds, or otherwise; to hold or in any manner dispose of the whole or any part of the property so purchased; to conduct in any lawful manner the whole or any part of any business so acquired and to exercise all the powers necessary or convenient in and about the conduct and management of such business.

(h) To borrow money and give security therefore; to loan money and take security therefore.

(i) To acquire by grant, purchase or otherwise, any property, privilege, or franchise from any government or other authority, individual, municipality, corporation, partnership, or otherwise, and to perform and fulfill the conditions thereof.

(j) To issue bonds, debentures, and evidences of indebtedness of all kinds to any amount authorized by the law for the purpose of obtaining funds for corporation purposes and to secure the payment of the same by pledge, mortgage, or deed of trust upon the whole or any part thereof.

(k) To sell and otherwise dispose of any bonds, debentures, or other obligations in such manner and upon such terms as the board of directors may deem proper and in keeping with the law.

(l) To conduct its business in all its branches and to have offices and unlimited to or otherwise acquire, own, hold, purchase, lease, mortgage, or otherwise dispose of and convey real and personal property; to erect and maintain buildings of every kind and for every purpose, and to lease, manage, operate and use the same anywhere on earth.

(m) To do everything necessary, suitable, and proper for the accomplishment of any of the purposes herein enumerated, or which may at any time appear conducive to or expedient of the protection of benefit of this corporation, and to do such other things as fully and to the same extent as a natural person might or could do, as principals, agents, directors, trustees, or otherwise, either alone or in conjunction with any other persons, association, firm, or corporation.

(n) It is expressly provided that the enumeration herein-

above its specified objects and powers shall be constructed as such shall not be held to limit or restrict, in any manner, the general powers of this corporation; provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall be deemed to authorize or permit the corporation to carry on any business or exercise any power to do any act which corporations formed under the law of the State of Idaho now or hereafter may not, at any time of such act, lawfully carry on, consummate or do, and the purposes, objects and powers specified in any one of the paragraphs of this Article III shall in no way restrict or limit by reference or inference the terms, objects, and powers of any other causes of paragraphs in this Article contained, nor in any of the other Articles of Incorporation.

FOURTH: The capital stock of this corporation shall be in the authorized amount of 50,000 shares of non-assessable Common Stock of no par value.

FIFTH: The corporation shall have the right, by appropriate, action to impose restrictions upon the transfer of any shares of its common stock, or any interest, therein, from time-to-time issued, provided that such restrictions as may from time-to-time be so imposed or notice of the substance thereof shall be set forth upon the face or the back of the certificates representing the shares of common stock.

SIXTH: The holders of the shares of commons stock of the corporation shall not be entitled to any preemptive right to purchase or subscribe for any unissued shares, treasury shares, or additional shares to be issued by reason of any increase in

the authorized shares of the corporation.

SEVENTH: Provisions for the regulations of the internal affairs of the corporation are: The By-Laws shall control the regulation and management of the internal affairs of the corporation.

EIGHTH: Cumulative voting on corporate business will not be permitted.

NINTH: The address of the initial registered office of the corporation is 1220 Queen of The Hills, Hailey Idaho 83333, and the name of its initial registered agent at such address is Alan R. Johnson.

The undersigned consents to the appointment as the initial registered agent of Wood River Finishes, Inc.
