ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of

DOLSEN LEASING COMPANY

The undersigned, a person of the age of eighteen (18) years or more, as incorporator of a corporation under the Washington Business Corporation Act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

ARTICLE I

Name

The name of the corporation is: DOLSEN LEASING COMPANY.

ARTICLE II

Duration

This corporation's duration shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE III

Purposes

The purpose, or purposes, for which the corporation is organized are:

Section 1: To engage in and carry on any lawful business or trade and exercise all powers granted to a corporation formed under the Washington Business Corporation Act, including any amendments thereto or successor statute that may hereinafter be enacted.

The foregoing clause of this Article III shall be construed as purposes and powers, and the matters expressed in same shall be in no way limited or restricted by reference to or inference from the terms of any other clauses, but shall be regarded as independent purposes and powers; and nothing contained in this clause shall be deemed in any way to limit or exclude any power, right or privilege given to this corporation by law or otherwise.

ARTICLE IV

Shares

This corporation shall have authority to issue

100,000 shares of common stock, and each share shall have a par value of \$1.00. There shall be no other class or shares of stock in this corporation.

ARTICLE V

Commencement of Business

This corporation will not commence business until consideration of the value of at least \$100,000.00 has been received for the issuance of its shares.

ARTICLE VI

Preemptive Rights

The owners of shares of stock of this corporation shall be entitled to preemptive rights to subscribe for or purchase any part of new or additional issues of stock or securities covertible into stock of any class whatsoever, whether now or hereafter authorized, and whether issued for cash, property, services, by way of dividends, or otherwise.

ARTICLE VII

Cumulative Voting

Each shareholder entitled to vote at any election for directors shall have the right to vote, in person or by proxy, the number of shares owned by him for as many persons as there are directors to be elected, and for whose election he has the right to vote, or cumulate his votes by giving as many votes as the number of such directors multiplied by the number of his shares shall equal, or by distributing such votes on the same principle among any number of candidates.

ARTICLE VIII

Contracts in Which Directors Have an Interest

Any contract or any other transaction between this corporation and one or more of its directors, or between this corporation and any corporation, firm, association or other entity of which one or more of its directors are shareholders, members, directors, officers or employees, or in which they are interested, shall be valid for all purposes, notwithstanding the presence of such director or directors at the meeting of the Board of Directors which acts upon or

in reference to such contract or transaction, and notwithstanding his or their participation in such action, by voting or otherwise, even though his or their presence or vote, or both, might have been necessary to obligate this corporation upon such contract or transaction; provided, that the fact of such interest shall be disclosed to or known by the directors acting on such contract or transaction.

ARTICLE IX Directors

The number of directors of this corporation shall be fixed by the By-Laws and may be increased or decreased from time to time in the manner specified therein. The initial Board of Directors shall consist of four (4) directors, and the names and addresses of the persons who shall serve as directors until the first annual meeting of shareholders, and until their successors are elected and qualified, unless they resign or are removed, are:



ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT

SECRETARY OF STATE STATE OF WASHINGTON

Pursuant to the provisions of RCW 23A.16 of the WASHINGTON BUSINESS CORPORATION ACT, the undersigned adopts the following Articles of Amendment to the Articles of Incorporation:

First: The name of the corporation is DOLSEN LEASING COMPANY.

Second: The following amendment of the Articles of Incorporation was adopted by the shareholders of the corporation on 26 day of June, 1981:

Article IV Shares of the Articles of Incorporation shall now read:

"This corporation shall have the authority to issue 200,000 shares of common stock, and each share shall have a par value of \$1.00. There shall be no other class or shares of stock in this corporation."

Third: The number of shares of the corporation outstanding at the time of such adoption was 100,000, and the number of shares entitled to vote thereon was 100,000.

Fourth: The designation and number of outstanding shares of each class entitled to vote thereon as a class were as follows: NONE

 $\underline{\text{Fifth}}$: The number of shares voted for such amendment was 100,000 ; and the number of shares voted against such amendment was none.

<u>Sixth</u>: The number of shares of each class entitled to vote thereon as a class voted for and against such amendment, respectively, was: NONE.

Seventh: The manner, if not set forth in such amendment, in which any exchange, reclassification, or cancellation of issued shares provided for in the amendment shall be effected,

is as follows: NO CHANGE.

<u>Eighth</u>: The manner in which such amendment effects a change in the amount of stated capital, and the amount of stated capital as changed by such amendment, are as follows:

The stated capital of the corporation shall be changed from 100,000 shares of common stock each having a par value of \$1.00 to 200,000 shares of common stock each having a par value of \$1.00 resulting in the amount of stated capital of \$200,000.00.
