

ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT

FOR

CHECK RECOVERY SYSTEMS, INC.

ARTICLE I. The name of the corporation is Check Recovery Systems, Inc.

ARTICLE II. The Amendments to the original Articles Incorporation adopted by the incorporation deal solely with the corporate name and are so follows: A. The caption shall be amended from: "Articles of Incorporation of Check Recovery Systems, Sc., Sto "Articles of Incorporation of Checkpower of Idaho, Inc."

> B. Article I shall be amended from: "The name of the corporation shall be Check Recovery Systems, Inc." to "The name of the corporation shall be Checkpower of Idaho, Inc."

C. Article IV shall be amended from: "The aggregate number of shares which Check Recovery Systems, Inc...." to, "The aggregate number of shares which Checkpower of Idaho, Inc...."
D. Article VI shall be amended from: "The number of directors constituting the initial board of directors for Check Recovery Systems, Inc. shall be three" to "The number of directors constituting the initial board of directors for Checkpower of Idaho, Inc., shall be three." E. Article VII shall be amended from "The incorporator of Check Recovery Services, Inc. is..." to "The incorporator of Checkpower of Idaho, Inc. is:

ARTICLE III. The date of the adoption of the amendment by the incorporator is May 10, 1984.

- ARTICLE IV. The number of shares outstanding is Ø . None of the shares were entitled to vote on the amendment, whether as a class or otherwise.
