ARTICLES OF CORPORATION

OF

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, all of whom are of full legal age and are citizens of the United States and the State of Idaho have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under and pursuant to the provisions of Title 30, Chapter 10, of the Idaho Code and do hereby adopt and exercise the following articles of incorporation and do hereby certify and declare:

ARTICLE I.

That the name of this corporation shall be:
BUHL ECONOMIC COUNCIL, INC.

ARTICLE II.

The purposes for which this corporation is formed are hereby as follows:

- (b) To acquire, own, purchase, hold, lease, sell and dispose of land, buildings and personal property within or in the vicinity of Buhl, Idaho.

(c) To barter, sell, exchange, or dispose in any way such land, buildings or personal property in whole or in part so owned or held by this corporation.

- (d) To rent, construct or buy buildings of any kind and to remodel, repair or enlarge any buildings so owned by this corporation.
- (e) To execute, make and enter into with other persons, firms or partnerships and corporations, contracts for the building and erection of factory buildings, commercial buildings, or any other type of buildings for and on behalf of other persons, firms, partnerships and corporations.
- (f) To advance money to and enter into contracts and arrangements of all kinds with builders and others who may be willing to build or improve any such land or buildings which this corporation is interested, including purchasers and prospective purchasers thereof.
- (g) To do each and everything necessary, suitable or proper for the accomplishment of any of the purposes, for the attainment of anyone or more of the objects herein enumerated, or conducive to or expedient for the interest or benefit of the corporation; and in addition, to exercise and possess all powers, rights and privileges necessary to or incidental to the purposes for which the corporation is organized, or to the activities of which it is engaged; and, in addition, any other rights, powers and privileges granted by the laws of the State of Idaho to corporations and to do any such thing anywhere, both within and without the State of Idaho.

ARTICLE III.

The principal place where its principal business will be transacted is Buhl, County of Twin Falls, Idaho, which is the registered office of the corporation.

ARTICLE IV.

That subject to disolution as provided by law, the duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE V.

The board of directors of said corporation shall not be less then five nor more than fifteen, which number of directors shall be fixed by the by-laws of the corporation.

ARTICLE VI.

- (a) This corporation shall not have any capital stock but shall admit members into the corporation upon the payment of a membership fee to be provided for in the by-laws of this corporation.
- (b) Voting power of the members of this corporation shall be equal and each member shall have one vote only.
- (c) This corporation is one which does not contemplate pucuniary gain or profit to the members thereof, and is not organized, and will not be conducted for that purpose, directly or indirectly.
- (d) Members of this corporation shall not be assessable and membership can not be terminated or cancelled so long as a member complies with these articles of incorporation, the by-laws to be adopted hereunder and the rules and regulations adopted by the Board of Directors for the government of members of this corporation.

(e) The rights and interest of all members in this corporation shall be equal and no member shall have or acquire a greater interest than any other member.

(f) The members of this association shall never be or become liable for the payment of any of the debts or liabilities of the association and the private property of the members shall not be subject to or liable for the payment of association debts to any extent whatever.

ARTICLE VII.

The power to repeal and amend the by-laws and adopt new by-laws is hereby confered upon the directors, as well as upon the members, to be exercised by a majority vote of said directors, or of the number of members of the corporation, as may be provided in the by-laws.

ARTICLE VIII.

All of the meetings of the members and of the Board of Directors may be held within or without the State of Idaho.
