1 ARTICLES OF CORPORATION

4 BUHL ECONOMIC COUNCIL, INC.

5 KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

6 That we, the undersigned, all of whom are of full legal
7 age and are citizens of the United States and the State of Idaho
8 have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the
9 purpose of forming a corporation under and pursuant to the pro-
10 visions of Title 30, Chapter 10, of the Idaho Code and do hereby
11 adopt and exercise the following articles of incorporation and
12 do hereby certify and declare:

13 ARTICLE I.

14 That the name of this corporation shall be:

15 BUHL ECONOMIC COUNCIL, INC.

16 ARTICLE II.

17 The purposes for which this corporation is formed
18 are hereby as follows:

19 (a) To foster, encourage, promote and improve the
20 industrial, commercial and physical development of the City of
21 Buhl, Twin Falls County, Idaho, by assisting, financially or
22 otherwise, the establishment of new industry and business or
23 the continuation and growth of present industry and business
24 within and in the vicinity of Buhl, Idaho.

25 (b) To acquire, own, purchase, hold, lease, sell and
26 dispose of land, buildings and personal property within or in the
27 vicinity of Buhl, Idaho.

1 (c) To barter, sell, exchange, or dispose in any way
2 such land, buildings or personal property in whole or in part
3 so owned or held by this corporation.

4 (d) To rent, construct or buy buildings of any kind
5 and to remodel, repair or enlarge any buildings so owned by this
6 corporation.

7 (e) To execute, make and enter into with other persons,
8 firms or partnerships and corporations, contracts for the building
9 and erection of factory buildings, commercial buildings, or any
10 other type of buildings for and on behalf of other persons,
11 firms, partnerships and corporations.

12 (f) To advance money to and enter into contracts and
13 arrangements of all kinds with builders and others who may be
14 willing to build or improve any such land or buildings which
15 this corporation is interested, including purchasers and pros-
16 pective purchasers thereof.

17 (g) To do each and everything necessary, suitable or
18 proper for the accomplishment of any of the purposes, for the
19 attainment of anyone or more of the objects herein enumerated, or
20 conducive to or expedient for the interest or benefit of the
21 corporation; and in addition, to exercise and possess all powers,
22 rights and privileges necessary to or incidental to the purposes
23 for which the corporation is organized, or to the activities of
24 which it is engaged; and, in addition, any other rights, powers
25 and privileges granted by the laws of the State of Idaho to
26 corporations and to do any such thing anywhere, both within and
27 without the State of Idaho.

2 ARTICLE III.

3 The principal place where its principal business will
4 be transacted is Buhl, County of Twin Falls, Idaho, which is the
5 registered office of the corporation.

6 ARTICLE IV.

7 That subject to dissolution as provided by law, the
8 duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.

9 ARTICLE V.

10 The board of directors of said corporation shall not
11 be less than five nor more than fifteen, which number of directors
12 shall be fixed by the by-laws of the corporation.

13 ARTICLE VI.

14 (a) This corporation shall not have any capital stock
15 but shall admit members into the corporation upon the payment
16 of a membership fee to be provided for in the by-laws of this
17 corporation.

18 (b) Voting power of the members of this corporation
19 shall be equal and each member shall have one vote only.

20 (c) This corporation is one which doesnot contemplate
21 pucuniary gain or profit to the members thereof, and is not
22 organized, and will not be conducted for that purpose, directly
23 or indirectly.

24 (d) Members of this corporation shall not be assessable
25 and membership can not be terminated or cancelled so long as
26 a member complies with these articles of incorporation, the by-
27 laws to be adopted hereunder and the rules and regulations
28 adopted by the Board of Directors for the government of members
of this corporation.

1 (e) The rights and interest of all members in this
2 corporation shall be equal and no member shall have or acquire
3 a greater interest than any other member.

4 (f) The members of this association shall never be
5 or become liable for the payment of any of the debts or liabilities
6 of the association and the private property of the members shall
7 not be subject to or liable for the payment of association debts
8 to any extent whatever.

9 ARTICLE VII.

10 The power to repeal and amend the by-laws and adopt
11 new by-laws is hereby conferred upon the directors, as well as
12 upon the members, to be exercised by a majority vote of said
13 directors, or of the number of members of the corporation, as
14 may be provided in the by-laws.

15
16 ARTICLE VIII.

17 All of the meetings of the members and of the Board
18 of Directors may be held within or without the State of Idaho.
