ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

MAX/WAY ENTERPRISES, INC.

The undersigned, in order to form a corporation pursuant to the Idaho Business Corporation Act, certify as follows:

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is MAX/WAY ENTERPRISES, INC. (hereafter "Corporation").

ARTICLE II

The purposes for which this Corporation is organized are as follows:

1. To engage in Sales and Small Business; and
2. To engage in any other lawful activity or business for which corporations may be incorporated under the Idaho Business Corporation Act.

ARTICLE III

The Corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE IV


