The undersigned, in order to form a Non-Profit Corporation under the provisions of Title 30, Chapter 3, Idaho Code, submits the following Articles of Incorporation to the Secretary of State:

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be Cornerstone Private School, Inc.

ARTICLE II

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is exclusively for religious, charitable, scientific, literary or educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and to transact any or all lawful business allowed under the Idaho Nonprofit Corporation Act.

ARTICLE III

The street address of the registered office shall be 1191 Mutch Creek Drive, St. Maries, Idaho 83861 and the registered agent shall be Melissa Bishop.

ARTICLE IV




The corporation does not have voting members.


ARTICLE VIII


