ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

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VICTOR AREA CHAMBER OF COMMERCE, INC.

[§30-323 I.C.]

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WE, THE UNDERSIGNED, Hereby incorporate ourselves under the Idaho Nonprofit Corporation Act [§§30-301ff. I.C.].

The name of the corporation shall be: VICTOR AREA CHAMBER OF COMMERCE.

ARTICLE II

The corporation is a nonprofit corporation.

ARTICLE III

The duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE IV

The purpose of the corporation is to transact any or all lawful business, for which corporations may be organized under such act, in the development and promotion of the economic and social welfare of Victor, Idaho, and its trade area, with particular emphasis upon promoting and assisting the development, growth, and expansion of the commercial, industrial, professional, agricultural, and civic interests of such city and area, and increasing employment opportunities for the residents thereof.

ARTICLE V

The address of the initial registered office of the corporation shall be Box 224, Victor, Idaho, 83455, but meetings of the board of directors and of any executive committee thereof, may be held at such registered office or at such other place, within or without this state, for the transaction of any business of the corporation, as the directors, by resolution or bylaw, might provide; and the name of its initial registered agent at such address is RICHARD GILDERSLEEVE.

ARTICLE VI

The initial board of directors shall consist of five persons, who are the incorporators, and whose names and addresses follow their signatures hereunder, such persons to serve as directors until the first meeting of members, or until their successors are elected and qualify.

ARTICLE VII

A. The corporation is not organized for pecuniary profit, and no part of its net earnings shall inure to the benefit of any member, director, or individual, and the balance of all money received by the corporation for its operations, after the payment in full of all debts and obligations of the corporation shall be held, used, or distributed, exclusively for educational, literary, and charitable purposes, within the intendment of $\S 501(c)(3)$ IRC.

- B. In the event of the dissolution of the corporation, all of the assets of the corporation shall be distributed to such nonprofit educational, literary, and charitable purposes, or municipal corporation, as the board of directors might select, within the intendment of $\S 501(c)(3)$ IRC.
- C. This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, literary, or educational purposes, within the intendment of §501(c)(3) IRC, and, notwith-standing any other provisions hereof, it shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization which is exempt from federal income taxes pursuant to such law.
