#### ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

J. M. F. CO., INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned, being natural persons of full age and citizens of the United States, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together, and do hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the general corporation laws of the State of Idaho and acts amendatory thereof and supplemental thereto, and do certify as follows:

# ARTICLE I

The corporate name of this corporation shall be J. M. F. CO., INC.

## ARTICLE II

The nature of the business and the purposes for which the corporation is formed are:

- 1. To engage in the trucking business, including the transportation of logs, lumber, building materials and other products.
- 2. To buy or otherwise acquire real estate of every kind and description in such manner and upon such terms as the Board of Directors may determine.

- 3. To engage in generally and carry on any lawful business or trade which may, in the judgment of the Board of Directors, at any time be necessary, useful or advantageous to the corporation.
- 4. In furtherance of and not in limitation of the general powers conferred by the State of Idaho, it is expressly provided that this corporation shall also have the following powers:
- (a) To acquire by purchase or otherwise and to own, hold, cancel, reissue, sell, pledge and otherwise deal in the stock of this corporation, provided that the money or property of the corporation shall not be used for purchase of shares of its own stock when such use would cause any impairment of the capital of the corporation. The corporation shall not be entitled to vote, either directly or indirectly, on any shares of its own stock which it may hold.
- (b) To acquire by purchase or otherwise and to own, hold, cancel, reissue, sell, pledge and otherwise deal in the bonds, debentures, notes and other securities and obligations of this corporation.
  - (c) To borrow money and give security therefor.
- (d) To enter into, make, perform and carry out the contracts of every kind for any lawful purposes pertaining to its business, with any individual, entity, firm, association or corporation or with any governmental, municipal or public

authority, domestic or foreign.

- (e) To do everything necessary, proper, convenient, or incidental to the accomplishment of the purposes and objects of this corporation, or which is calculated directly or indirectly to promote the welfare or interest of the corporation or enhance the value or render profitable any of its property or rights.
- (f) To do any and all of these things in this Article set forth to the same extent a natural person might or could do, and in any part of the world, as principles, agents, contractors, trustees or otherwise, either alone or in company with others.

PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that nothing herein contained shall be deemed to authorize or permit the corporation to carry on any business, to exercise any power or to do any act which a corporation formed under the laws of the State of Idaho, or any amendment thereto or substitute therefor, may not at any time lawfully carry on or do.

#### ARTICLE III

The location of the registered office of this corporation in the State of Idaho is 821 Washington Avenue, Saint Maries, Idaho 83861.

# ARTICLE IV

The time of existence of this corporation shall be perpetual.

## ARTICLE V

There shall be three directors who shall manage the business of the corporation.

# ARTICLE VI

The total number of shares of stock which this corporation is authorized to issue is 2,500 and the par value of each share is \$10.00 for a total authorized capital of \$25,000.00.
