

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE LADIES OF THE
GRAND ARMY OF THE REPUBLIC, DEPARTMENT OF IDAHO.

KNOW ALL MEN by these presents, that we whose names are
subscribed hereto, do, under and in pursuance of the General
Corporation Law of the State of Idaho, hereby organize, constitute
and associate ourselves into a corporation, and to that end exe-
cute the following, which, when duly executed, legally filed,
recorded and certified as required by the laws of Idaho, shall
constitute the Articles of Incorporation of The Ladies of the
Grand Army of the Republic, Department of Idaho.

We do hereby set forth and declare as follows:

FIRST, That the name of this Corporation is The Ladies of
The Grand Army of The Republic .

SECOND, The purpose for which this Corporation is organized
are; To teach patriotism and lessons of good citizenship ; to
proclaim the idea of one vast sisterhood in the practice of the
Golden Rule; to perpetuate the deeds and sacrifices of the Grand
Army of the Republic.

THIRD, That the place where its principal business is to be
transacted is Boise, Ada County, Idaho.

FOURTH, The term for which it is to exist is limited to Fifty
Years.

FIFTH, The number of its directors, known as The Council of
Administration, shall be three.

SIXTH, This Corporation, being a Non Profit Cooperative
Association, there is no Capital Stock.
