Petition of J. C. Nelson et al. for the Incorporation of Oakley is a village taken up and considered; After due deliberation the petition is granted, and the Village of Oakley incorporated so as to embrace the following described tract of land, to wit: Commencing at the Northwest corner of the Southeast quarter of Section 34 Township 13 South of Range 22 East, Boise Meridian thence East 3 miles, thence South 1 mile, thence ~~West~~ West 3 miles, thence North one (1) mile to place of beginning and

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it is hereby ordered that the following named persons shall hold the office of Trustees of each village for the unexpired term or until the next regular election, viz: John L. Smith, George S. P. Miller, et al. and P. Swails, and that they do to certify the said parties of their appointments.

In the matter of instructing a bridge across Snake River at a point known as the narrows, there being no petition to construct such bridge, the matter was dismissed and it is ordered that the same be no further considered by this matter.

No more petitions being on file the Board took up Officers oath and allowed bills as follows

Liquor Bond of J. E. Burke, of Rock Creek, approved

 Liquor Bond of B. C. Witt, of Albion, approved.

Petition of H. C. Haight, and others, of Oakley, asking for the granting of a Village Incorporation; Whereupon the Board fully satisfying themselves that a majority of the taxable inhabitants of the proposed Village Incorporation had signed said Petition, and that inhabitants to the number of more than two hundred are actual residents of the territory described in said Petition, it is by the Board Ordered: That the said Village be and the same is hereby, Incorporated into a Village Incorporation, to be known as the Village of Oakley, Cassia County, State of Idaho, with the following metes and boundary lines, to wit: Beginning at the North East corner of the North West quarter of section thirty four in Township 13 South of Range 22 East of Boise Meridian; thence running West along the section line three miles to the North West corner of the North East quarter of section Thirty one, in Tp. 13 S. of Range 22 East of the Boise Meridian; thence running South along the half section line, two miles to the North West corner of the North East quarter of Section seven, in Tp 14 South of Range 22 East of Boise Meridian; thence running East along the section line three miles to the North East corner of the North West quarter of section Ten in Tp 14 South of Range 22 East of Boise Meridian; thence running North along the half section line two miles to the place of beginning. And it is further ordered by the Board, that the following named persons, to wit: David P. Thomas, Solomon E. Hale, Solomon P. Worthington, Dan P. Albee and Jacob Dayley, are hereby appointed Trustees of the said Village of Oakley, until the election and qualification of their successors as provided by law.
