Petition of H. C. Haight, and others, of Oakley, asking for the granting
 of a Village Incorporation; Whereupon the Board fully satisfying them-
 selves that a majority of the taxable inhabitants of the proposed Village
 Incorporation had signed said Petition, and that inhabitants to the num-
 ber of more than two hundred are actual residents of the territory described
 in said Petition, it is by the Board Ordered: That the said Village be
 and the same is hereby, Incorporated into a Village Incorporation,
 to be known as the Village of Oakley, Cassia County, State of Idaho,
 with the following metes and boundary lines, to wit: Beginning at the
 North East corner of the North West quarter of Section thirty four in Township
 13 South of Range 22 East of Boise Meridian; thence running West along
 the section line three miles to the North West corner of the North East
 quarter of section Thirty one, in Tp. 13 S. of Range 22 East of the Boise
 Meridian; thence running South along the half section line, two miles
 to the North West corner of the North East quarter of Section seven, in
 Tp 14 South of Range 22 East of Boise Meridian; thence running East along
 the section line three miles to the North East corner of the North West quarter
 of section Ten in Tp 14 South of Range 22 East of Boise Meridian; thence
 running North along the half section line two miles to the place of
 beginning. And it is further ordered by the Board, that the following
 named persons, to wit: David P. Thomas, Solomon E. Hale, Solomon P.
 Worthington, Dan P. Albee and Jacob Dayley, are hereby appointed Trustees
 of the said Village of Oakley, until the election and qualification of their
 successors as provided by law.
