ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

MILFORD L. MIDDELSTAEDT and MARK B. WHITING, being separately sworn each upon oath deposes and says:

That Milford L. Middestaedt is the duly elected, qualified and acting Vice President and Mark B. Whiting is the duly elected, qualified and acting Assistant Secretary of Continental Life & Accident Company; that on January 11, 1988, pursuant to a call for a meeting of the stockholders of the Continental Life & Accident Company, issued by the Board of Directors on December 28, 1987, and pursuant to proper written notice of the time, place and purpose of the meeting given to all stockholders of record of said corporation, which notice stated among other things the specific purpose to be to amend Article VIII of the Company's Articles of Incorporation, the effect of which amendment would be to change the minimum number of Directors to be not less than five (5) nor more than fifteen (15).

A meeting of the stockholders of said corporation was duly convened and held on January 11, 1988. The vote to amend the Articles was unanimous in that all shares represented at said meeting resolved to amend Article VIII of the Articles of Incorporation of Continental Life & Accident Company to read as follows:

ARTICLE VIII

The Directors of this corporation shall not be less than five (5) nor more than fifteen (15) in number.

The First Board of Directors who shall manage the affairs of the corporation shall be five in number and the Directors shall have the power from time to time and at any time when the stockholders are not assembled in a meeting, regular or special, to increase their own number to not more than fifteen and forthwith appoint and elect any other person or persons to be Directors to hold office until the next annual election and until their successors are elected and qualified.

All of which appears upon and is of record in the minutes of said meeting, duly recorded in the Minute Book of said corporation.
