KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, desiring to associate ourselves together and of forming a corporation under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Idaho, for the purposes hereinafter set forth and specified, do make, acknowledge, publish, declare and certify the following to be our articles of incorporation.

ARTICLE I.

The name of this corporation shall be the Shelley Mercantile Company, Limited.

ARTICLE II.

The purposes and objects for which this corporation is formed is to carry on and conduct a general merchandise and manufacturing business, and for such purpose, buy and sell, and hold such real estate as may be necessary; buy and sell merchandise, produce and live-stock, of every character; manufacture articles of merchandise; borrow money and make and execute its notes therefor; and buy and sell negotiable papers and contracts.

ARTICLE III.

That the place where the principal business of said corporation is to be transacted is Shelley, in the County of Blaine, State of Idaho.

ARTICLE IV.

That the term for which corporation is to exist is fifty (50) years from and after the date of its incorporation, unless sooner dissolved by the proper order of the court.

ARTICLE V.

That the capital stock of this corporation is Fifty

2 Thousand (\$50,000.) Dollars, divided into five hundred shares of the value of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars per share.

ARTICLE VI.

The amount of the capital stock actually subscribed and the names of the persons subscribing for same are as follows:
