all I have.

This is about the umpteenth
time that I've had to try to
clear up this hilarious situation.

I've lived at my present location
for over 10 years, in the State of Idaho
about 1/2 mi. from the Washington
border. Idaho evidently has an
agreement with the State of

Washington to deliver our mail from the Newport Washington P. O.

I used to have a mail box in front of my house, Route 2 Box 88C, Newport, Washington, even though I really lived in Idaho, honestly.

I also had a P. O. Box # H at the Blanchard, Idaho P. O. $2\frac{1}{2}$ miles from where I live. Blanchard does not have a mailman for rural delivery so we have to pick up our mail at the Blanchard P. O.

The Newport Post Office decided that they were not going to deliver my mail at two different places, so, I chose the Blanchard Idaho Post Office Box # H so that people would believe that I actually lived in Idaho.

Now please tell me what should

be done, we do not have street addresses or route numbers unless we want to use a Washington address because they are the ones that deliver the mail and are not about to call themselves Idahoans well, I'm one and proud of it.

My sister is 84 years old, she lives in Iowa with a proper street address, has been out here and knows that I live in Idaho. I do believe at the time that she thought it was a bit "tetchy," in the head for using a Washington address.
