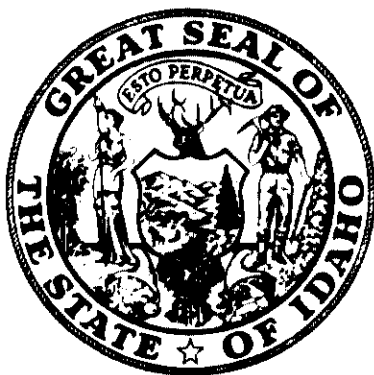

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ADOPTION OF AMENDMENT

THE STATE OF IDAHO
COUNTY OF TWIN FALLS

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF CHAPEL OF PRAISE, INCORPORATED,
TWIN FALLS, IDAHO, IN CONFERENCE ASSEMBLED:

That the trustees and members of said organization assembled on
the tenth day of April, 1988 to make amendment to Article X of
said corporation. It was voted upon and passed unanimously.

Article X of Chapel of Praise, Incorporated, Twin Falls, Idaho
shall be amended as follows:

ARTICLE X

The means, assets and income and real property of this
corporation shall be managed by the Pastors Advisory Board subject
always to the approval of the membership of this corporation.

Upon the winding up and dissolution of this corporation,
after paying or adequately providing for the debts and obligations
of the corporation, the remaining assets shall be distributed to a
nonprofit fund, foundation, or corporation which is organized and
operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious and/or
scientific purposes and which has established its tax exempt status
under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the
organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted
to be carried on; (a) by an organization exempt from Federal income
tax under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954
(or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal
Revenue Law) or; (b) by an organization contributions to which are
deductible under section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of
1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States
Internal Revenue Law.)
