One Thousand Nine Hundred and twenty-seven and is duly recorded in Book A-20 of Domestic Corporations, Records of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Section 4696 of Idaho Compiled Statutes, to-wit:

FIRST, The name of the Corporation as aforesaid; SECOND, The purpose for which it was formed; THIRD, The place where its principal business is to be transacted; FOURTH, The term for which it is to exist; FIFTH, The number of its directors or trustees; SIXTH, The amount of its capital stock and the number of shares into which it is divided; SEVENTH, The amount of its capital stock actually subscribed and by whom.

AND I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a body politic and corporate, by the name stated in the articles, for the term of fifty years.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION.

of

MOUNTAIN HOME SHEEP COMPANY.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we, the undersigned, Pedro M. Gandiango, Peter Ami, and Stanton Park, each residing at Mountain Home, Idaho, and each a nona fide resident of the State of Idaho, have this day, voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, and to that end execute this instrument, which, when certified, filed and recorded as by law required, shall constitute the articles of incorporation of Mountain Home Sheep Company, and we do certify:

I.

That the name of said corporation is Mountain Home Sheep Company.

II.

That the purposes for which said corporation is formed are: to engage in and conduct a general livestock business, including, without excluding by reason of the specific enumeration following, such matters as would otherwise fall within the general purpose stated, the raising, buying or otherwise acquiring, holding, maintaining, breeding, growing, handling, marketing, feeding, fattening, grazing, selling, mortgaging, hypothecating, or otherwise disposing of, sheep and all other kinds of livestock; to carry on the general business of farming; to raise, buy, grow or otherwise acquire, hold, handel, market, sell, mortgage, hypothecate or otherwise dispose of, wool and farm products; to deal and traffic generally in livestock, wool and farm products; to buy, lease or otherwise acquire, hold, sell, convey, mortgage or otherwise dispose of, real estate and any and all interests therein; to do any act or thing necessary or convenient in the transaction of the aforesaid kinds of business, and to have exercise and enjoy all the general powers and privileges of like corporations organized under the laws of the State of Idaho.

III.

That the place where the principal business of this corporation is to be transacted is, and shall be, in Mountain Home, Elmore County, State of Idaho, and the principal office of said corporation shall be located there.

IV.

That the term for which said corporation is to exist is fifty years from and after the date hereof.

V.

That the number of its directors is three.

VI.

That the amount of the capital stock of this corporation shall be Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00), divided into Five Hundred (500) shares of the par value of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) each.

VII.

That the amount of the capital stock of such corporation which has been actually subscribed is Three Hundred Dollars, and the following are the names of the persons by whom the same has been subscribed, together with the number of shares and the amount so subscribed set opposite the name of each subscriber;
