

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE O. SGA PHI ALPHA SOCIETY.

We, the undersigned, a majority of whom are bona fide residents and citizens of the state of Idaho, do hereby voluntarily associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a nonstock, social, benevolent corporation, under and pursuant to the laws of the state of Idaho in such case made and provided.

ARTICLE ONE.

The name of this corporation shall be "THE O. SGA PHI ALPHA SOCIETY".

ARTICLE TWO.

That the object and purpose of this corporation are to promote social intercourse among its members; to assist worthy young women to pursue courses of study in the University of Idaho, and to that end acquire by purchase, gift, or otherwise, real and personal property, to own and hold the same by lease or otherwise; to build, maintain and operate a suitable and appropriate dwelling house in the City of Moscow, County of Latah, State of Idaho, and all such property to sell, dispose of and convey; to incur such indebtedness as shall be deemed necessary for the carrying out of the purposes of this corporation; to issue negotiable notes, bonds, or other evidences of indebtedness, for the purposes of securing funds for the purposes and objects and aims of this corporation and to secure the payment thereof by mortgage or trust deed or other security, upon the real or personal property of this corporation, and do any or all things necessary,

convenient, expedient or proper for the carrying out of the purposes of this corporation.

ARTICLE THREE.

That under no circumstances or conditions shall this corporation engage in any gainful business or occupation, or declare dividends to its members under any guise or pretext whatsoever, but all funds and property of this corporation shall be devoted solely and exclusively to the benevolent and social purposes herein mentioned.

ARTICLE FOUR.

The principal office and place of business of this corporation shall be in the city of Moscow, County of Latah, State of Idaho.

ARTICLE FIVE.

The term for which this corporation shall exist is (50) fifty years.

ARTICLE SIX.

The number of directors of this corporation shall be six (6).

ARTICLE SEVEN.

The Board of Directors shall be elected annually at such time as is provided in the by-laws of this corporation, and shall hold office for a term of one (1) year and until their successors are elected

and qualified.

ARTICLE EIGHT.

That prior to the execution of these articles of incorporation, to-wit: on the 9th day of May 1921, The Omega Phi Alpha Sorority, a voluntary, benevolent, and social association, in contemplation of this incorporation, held an election for directors pursuant to notice as provided by law, which notice designated the time and place of holding the said election and the purposes for which the same was to be held, and was published for two full weeks prior to the date of such election in the Daily Star Mirror, a public newspaper printed and published in the City of Moscow, County of Latah, State of Idaho, once each week for three consecutive weeks, the first publication thereof being on the 15th day of April 1921, the second publication thereof being on the 25th day of April 1921, and the third publication thereof being on the 2nd day of May 1921, and further by posting a like notice for two full weeks in a conspicuous place on the building in which said election was held, to-wit: on the front door of said building on Blake Avenue, City of Moscow, County of Latah, State of Idaho, which building is occupied by the Omega Phi Alpha Sorority and in which said election was held.

ARTICLE NINE.

That at the date and place aforesaid,

the same being the time and place fixed in the said notice for election of directors, the following named persons were duly and regularly elected directors.
