KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, Walter F. Rabe of Edina, Minnesota, W. L. Rinehart of Spokane, Washington, and H. E. McGinty of Minneapolis, Minnesota, and all being citizens of the United States of America, being desirous of forming a corporation for the purposes hereinafter specified and in conformity with the laws of the State of Washington, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves and do hereby voluntarily associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Washington, and do hereby make and adopt the following Articles of Incorporation, in triplicate.

ARTICLE I

The corporate name of this company shall be

SEVEN-UP BOTTLING CO.
OF SPOKANE

ARTICLE II

The objects and purposes for which this corporation is organized and the nature of the business to be carried on by it are stated to be as follows, to-wit:

(a) To make, manufacture, purchase, process by formula or by recipe, produce or otherwise acquire and sell for itself or on commission, or otherwise, soft drinks of any and every kind whatsoever; to make or otherwise acquire, market or use formulas and recipes for the manufacture or processing of soft drinks of any and every kind whatsoever; to act as factor, agent, jobber, distributor or in any other capacity of or for individuals, firms and corporations in the manufacture, processing, production and sale of any and every kind of soft drink; to purchase or otherwise acquire, own, hold, lease and improve or operate any and all kinds of property

whether real, personal or mixed, for factories, offices, storage warehouses or for any other purpose in connection with said business; to purchase or otherwise acquire any property of any person, firm or corporation or the capital stock of any corporation.

(b) To invest and reinvest the funds of the company in any and all kinds of securities; to borrow money for its purposes and to issue its evidences of indebtedness therefor and to secure the same by pledge, mortgage or hypothecation in any form deemed by the Board of Directors to be to the best interests of the company; to loan the money of the corporation upon such terms as to the Board of Directors may seem expedient and to receive mortgages or other securities or form of security therefor; and

(c) Generally, to carry on, conduct and undertake any business transactions or operation of any kind within or without the State of Washington and any other incidental business which may seem to the Board of Directors convenient to carry on in connection with the above and calculated directly or indirectly to enhance the value of or render profit in connection with the company's business property or rights.

ARTICLE III

The amount of the Capital Stock of this corporation shall be as follows: One Hundred Thousand (\$100,000.00) Dollars, consisting of One Thousand (1000) shares of Common Stock having a par value of One Hundred (\$100) Dollars per share. The amount of paid in capital with which said corporation shall commence business will be One Hundred Thousand (\$100,000.00) Dollars.

ARTICLE IV

The time of the existence of this company shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE V

The Directors of the company shall not be less than three (3), but may be increased to any number not exceeding five (5) by vote of the stockholders, or Board of Directors.

ARTICLE VI

The names and residences of the Directors who shall manage the affairs of this company until the first annual meeting of stockholders, to-wit: the first day of May, 1946, or until their successors are elected and qualified, shall be:

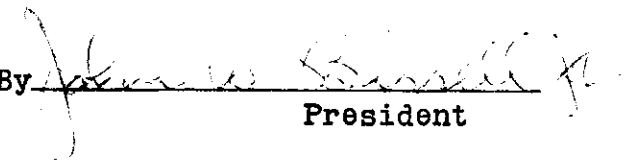
