

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
CONCERNED CITIZENS FOR SCHOOL BOARD
& SUPERINTENDENT ACTIONS, INC.

ARTICLE 1

The name of this corporation is Concerned Citizens for School Board & Superintendent Actions, Inc.

ARTICLE 2

The specific and primary purpose for which this organization is formed is to provide, directly or indirectly, means to improve the quality of education by electing responsible people to manage the fiscal and educational activities of the school district, and to assist development of better, and more effective communication between the community and members of the school board.

The general purposes for which this corporation is formed are to have and exercise all rights and powers conferred on non-profit corporations under the laws of Idaho.

Notwithstanding any other provision therein, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the primary purpose of this corporation; no part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of any member, private shareholder, or individual.

DURATION

The duration of this corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE 3

This corporation is organized pursuant to the general nonprofit corporation law of the State of Idaho. This corporation does not contemplate pecuniary gain or profit to its members and is organized for nonprofit purposes.

ARTICLE 4

Section 4.1. Members. The members of this corporation shall consist of residents of North Idaho. The number of members shall be as from time to time determined by the membership, but shall never be less than the number of trustees. The members shall be selected in such manner and for such terms as the bylaws may provide.

ARTICLE 5

Section 5.1. Trustees - Selection. The management and administration of the affairs of this corporation shall be a board of directors, consisting of not less than nine (9) persons who are generally representative of varied elements or organizations in the area served by the corporation. The number, qualifications, terms of office, manner of elections, time and

place of meetings, and the powers and duties of trustees shall be as prescribed in the bylaws of the corporation.

Section 5.2. Trustees - Compensation. No member of the board of trustees shall receive any compensation for his or her services as member of the board of trustees, but the corporation may pay reasonable compensation to any persons including a member of the board of trustees for other services actually rendered to the corporation.

ARTICLE 8

The authorized number and qualification of members of the corporation, the different classes of membership, if any, the property, voting other rights and privileges of members and their liability for dues and assessments and the method of collection thereof, shall be as set forth in the bylaws.

ARTICLE 9

Upon the winding up and dissolution of the corporation, after paying or adequately providing for the debts and obligations of this corporation, the remaining assets shall be distributed to one or more organizations exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(C)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code

of 1954 as it may be, from time to time, amended. In the event that a petition is filed pursuant to the Idaho Corporation Code by the Attorney General or any person concerned in liquidation proceedings to which the Attorney General is a party, the assets shall be disposed as provided in that section. The property, assets, profits, and net income of this Corporation are irrevocably dedicated to charitable purposes and no part of the net income or assets shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer, or member thereof or to any private individual.
