CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

I, FRED E. LUKENS, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

SNAKE RIVER AREA COUNCIL, INCORPORATED

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the twenty-first day of June A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred thirty and is duly recorded in Book A-24 of Record of Domestic Corporations of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Section 3 of Chapter 262 of the 1929 Session Laws of Idaho, and Sections 4870 and 4871, Idaho Compiled Statutes, as amended by Chapter 196 of the 1925 Session Laws.

AND I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name stated in the articles, and for perpetual existence from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at TWIN FALLS in the County of TWIN FALLS, Idaho, and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Religious, Ex-Service Men, Benevolent, Charitable and Fraternal Corporations, as provided in Chapter 196, Idaho Compiled Statutes.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and affixed the Great Seal of the State. Done at Boise City, the Capital of Idaho, this twenty-first day of June, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and thirty, and of the Independence of the United States of America the One Hundred and Fifty-fourth.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
SNAKE RIVER AREA COUNCIL, INCORPORATED

BE IT KNOWN That the members of Snake River Area Council of the Boy Scouts of America hereby incorporate themselves as a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho relating to religious, social and benevolent corporations, with articles of incorporation as follows:

(1) The name of this corporation shall be: Snake River Area Council, Incorporated.

(2) The purposes for which this corporation is formed are:

To promote the Boy Scout program within the territory embraced in Snake River Area Council of the Boy Scouts of America, and to assist in extending the benefits of Boy Scout training, ideals and opportunities to all eligible boys in said region, in harmony with the National Council, Boy Scouts of America, and the Snake River Area Council thereof;

To acquire, lease, purchase, own, hold, maintain, operate and improve camping places and camping facilities for the use of Boy Scouts within the territory embraced in said Snake River Area Council; to acquire, lease, buy, own and hold such real and personal property as may be necessary to accomplish all the purposes foregoing; to receive, take and hold such gifts and donations, whether of real or personal property, as may be made to the corporation, and to take, receive and hold real or personal property in trust upon the conditions and for the purposes prescribed by the donor thereof; to sell, lease or otherwise dispose of, any of its real or personal property when no longer needed or suitable for the use of the corporation, provided that the proceeds thereof shall not be diverted from the purposes for which this corpor-

ation is organized, and provided further that clauses 7 and 8 of Section 2, By-Laws of the National Council, Boy Scouts of America, shall govern in the event of a dissolution of this corporation.

To borrow money, and to evidence such indebtedness by promissory notes or other instruments, and to secure the payment thereof by mortgage, pledge or other lien upon real or personal property.

(3) The members of this corporation shall be the members from time to time of Snake River Area Council of the Boy Scouts of America, in accordance with the constitution and by-laws of the National Council, Boy Scouts of America, and the constitution and by-laws of said Snake River Area Council, as the same may now or hereafter read.

(4) The government of this corporation shall be vested in a board of 5 directors, elected annually by and from among the members of the corporation, which board shall elect a president, vice-president and treasurer from their number, and a secretary who need not be a member of the board.

(5) The location of the registered office of this corporation shall be Twin Falls, Idaho.

(6) This corporation is not organized for profit; no member or officer of this corporation shall directly or indirectly make any profit from the operations of this corporation, nor be interested in any contract made by it, except that the secretary may receive a fixed salary as such.

(7) The names and post office addresses of the members chosen as the first board of directors, to serve until the first annual meeting of the corporation are:

all of whom are residents of the State of Idaho.
