ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION 16 NAMPA DOOR SUPPLY SOME OF

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned, acting as incorporators of a corporation under the Idaho Business Corporation Act, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

ARTICLE I.

The name of this corporation is NAMPA DOOR SUPPLY COMPANY.

ARTICLE II.

The objects and purposes for which this corporation are formed are:

The transaction of any or all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the Idaho Business Corporation Act.

ARTICLE III.

The corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE IV.

The location and address of the registered office of the corporation shall be, and is 4904 Greenhurst Road, Nampa, Idaho 83651, and the name of its initial registered agent at such address is GLEN HOLLADAY.

ARTICLE V.

The amount of the capital stock of the corporation shall be, and is \$10,000.00, divided into 10,000 shares. Each such share shall have a par value of \$1.00. Said stock shall be and is nonassessable.

ARTICLE VI.

The names and post office addresses of the incorporators and the number of shares subscribed by each are as follows:

ARTICLE VII.

The private property of the stockholders of the corporation shall not be subject to the payment of corporate debts to any extent whatever, and the shares of the corporation shall not be subject to assessment for the purpose of paying expenses, conducting business or paying debts of the corporation.

ARTICLE VIII.

- (a) The corporation shall not have a board of directors, but shall be run and managed directly by the shareholders.
 - (b) The incorporators set forth above are the only

shareholders of the corporation.

ARTICLE IX.

No contract or other transaction between the corporation and any other corporation and no act of the corporation shall in any way be affected or invalidated by the fact that any of the directors of the corporation are pecuniarily or otherwise interested in or are directors or officers of such other corporation; any directors, individual or any firm of which they may be a member, may be a party or may be pecuniarily or otherwise interested in any contract or transaction of the corporation provided that they or such firm so interested shall be disclosed or shall have been known to the Board of Directors of the corporation which shall authorize any such contract or transaction with like force and effect as if they were not so interested.
