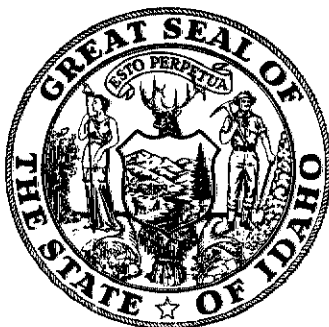

The Gooding County Search and Rescue Association, Incorporated amended the association Articles of Incorporation at the regular meeting held on September 12, 1995, presided over by President, Brad Bickford.

The Gooding County Search and Rescue Association, Incorporated has 24 members qualified to vote. There were 18 members present at the meeting on September 12, 1995. The vote was unanimous in favor of adopting the following amendments and additions to the Articles of Incorporation.

Article 3 is amended to add the following item:

3. d. This organization is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Article 9 is amended to read as follows:

9. Upon dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

Article 10 is added and read as follows:

10. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
