KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That the undersigned, Alfred M. Jansen, Evelyn F. Jansen and Joyce L. Jansen, each being of full legal age, and a citizen of the United States, have now associated themselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Washington, and in pursuance thereof do hereby sign and acknowledge the following Articles of Incorporation, in triplicate originals, and do state as follows:

I.

That the corporate name of this corporation shall be Jansen Agency, Inc.

II.

That the purposes for which this corporation is formed are the following:

To act as agent or broker for insurance companies in soliciting and receiving applications for fire, casualty, plate glass, automobiles, trucks and other motor vehicles, boiler, elevator, accident, health, burglary, rent, marine, credit, and life insurance, and all other kinds of insurance, the collection of premiums, and doing such other business as may be delegated to agents or brokers by such companies and to conduct a general insurance agency and insurance brokerage business.

To act as the agent of such persons, firms associations, and corporations as shall employ it to investigate, collect, and report information concerning insurance applicants and risks, and to prepare, present, adjust, settle, collect, and purchase claims arising under insurance policies, and such other business as is incidental to such business.

To transact the business of investing on behalf of itself or others, any part of its capital and such additional funds as it may obtain, or any interest therein, either as tenant in common or otherwise, and selling or otherwise disposing of the same, or any part thereof, or interest therein.

To purchase, improve, develop, lease, exchange, sell, dispose of, and otherwise deal in and turn to account, real estate; to purchase, lease, build, construct, erect, occupy, and manage buildings of every kind and character whatsoever; to finance the purchase, improvement, development, and construction of land and buildings belonging to or to be acquired by this corporation, or any other person, firm, or corporation.

To transact the business of a real estate agent or broker, and in behalf of others, to buy, sell, deal in, lease, rent and manage real estate and any interest therein.

To purchase, acquire, and take over the business of the co-partnership of Alfred M. Jansen and Evelyn F. Jansen, his wife, d/b/a Jansen Agency, Newport, Washington, as a general insurance and real estate business, and all of its ramifications, as it is now presently existing.

To engage in any commercial, industrial, and agricultural enterprise calculated or designed to be profitable to this corporation, and in conformity with the laws of the State of Washington.

To generally engage in, do, and perform any enterprise, act or vocation that a natural person might or could do or perform; to engage in the manufacture, sale, purchase, importing and exporting of merchandise and personal property of all manner and description, to act as agents for the purchase, sale, and handling of goods, wares, real estate, and merchandise of any and all types and descriptions for the account of the Corporation or as factor, agent, procurer, or otherwise for or on behalf of another.

III.

That this Corporation shall continue perpetually.

IV.

That the location and post-office of the address of the registered office of this Corporation shall be: 124 S. Washington Avenue, Newport, Washington.

V.

That the total authorized number of par value share shall be fifty thousand, and they shall be of the par value of \$1.00, and such shares shall be non-assessable, and classified as common stock.

VI.

That the amount of paid-in capital of which this Corporation shall begin business is the sum of \$500.00 in Cash and/or property of that value.

VII.

That the number of Directors of this Corporation shall not be less than three nor more than thirteen; that the number, qualifications, terms of office, manner of election, time and place of meeting, and the powers and duties of the Directors shall be such as are prescribed by the by-laws of this Corporation; that the names and post-office addresses of the first Directors who shall hold office and manage the affairs of the Corporation for the period of one year after its incorporation are as follows:

The Corporation reserves the right to amend, alter, change or repeal any provision contained in these Articles of Incorporation in any manner now or hereafter prescribed by statute, and all rights conferred upon shareholders are subject to this reservation.

IX.

That authority to make by-laws for this Corporation is hereby expressly vested in the Board of Directors of this Corporation, subject to the power of the shareholders to change or repeal the said by-laws.
