ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

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ARTICLE TWO - ORGANIZING & NAME CO., INC.

THESE are the Articles of Incorporation, made by the undersigned, the legal heirs of the said deceased, of legal age, single and sane, voluntarily associating themselves together for the purpose of forming a private corporation under the laws of the State of Illinois, to have for object:

ARTICLE III.

THE NAME OF THIS CORPORATION IS "HARTFORD ORGANIZING & NAME CO., INC." and its principal office is in Chicago.

ARTICLE IV.

THE PURPOSES AND OBJECTS OF THIS CORPORATION, and the powers and authorities which it shall possess, shall be as follows:

(a) To carry on any and all business, manufacturing, promoting, investing, managing, etc., which, in its discretion, the Board of Directors, or the stockholders, may deem proper, and to do all such things as may be necessary or proper to carry out the purposes and objects of the corporation, and to do all such things as may be necessary or proper to carry out the purposes and objects of the corporation.

(b) To purchase, lease, hold, sell, convey, mortgage, and otherwise dispose of real and personal property, and to do all such things as may be necessary or proper to carry out the purposes and objects of the corporation, and to do all such things as may be necessary or proper to carry out the purposes and objects of the corporation.

(r) To carry out all or any part of the foregoing objects or purposes as principal or agent, or otherwise, either alone or in conjunction with any person, association or other corporation and in any part of the world, and in carrying out its business and for its purposes of acquiring or purchasing any of its objects or purposes, to make and perform such contracts of any kind and description, to do such acts or such things and to exercise any and all such powers as a natural person could lawfully law, perform, do or exercise provided that the same are not inconsistent with the objects or purposes of this corporation, or the statutes of the State of Idaho.

(s) To conduct its business in all or any of its branches in the State of Idaho and in any and all other states, territories, possessions, colonies and dependencies of any United States or Mexico and in the District of Columbia, and in any or all foreign countries, and to have one or more offices within or outside of the State of Idaho.

(t) The objects as specified herein shall, except as otherwise expressed, be in no way limited or restricted by reference to or inferences from the terms of any other clause or paragraph of these articles. The objects, purposes and powers specified in each of the clauses or paragraphs in these articles shall be regarded as independent objects, purposes and powers.

The foregoing objects and purposes shall be construed also as powers and the enumeration thereof shall not be held to limit or restrain in any manner the general powers now or hereafter conferred on this corporation by the statutes of the State of Idaho.

ARTICLE III.

The location and post office address of the registered office of this corporation in the State of Idaho shall be 1223 First Street, North, Nampa, Idaho.

ARTICLE IV.

This corporation is authorized to issue one class of shares to be designated as capital stock, the total number of shares of capital stock which this corporation shall be authorized to issue is 500 shares and each share shall be of the par value of \$100.00, making a total aggregate par value of \$50,000.00.

ARTICLE V.
