ATTACHEMENT TO IDAHO FORM ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION (NON-PROFIT)

ARTICLE 2: The purpose for which the corporation is organized is:

The organization is organized exclusively for charitable purposes under Section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code to preserve Idaho lands in their natural form to provide habitats for Idaho wildlife and for the enjoyment of public use in and around urban developing areas of the state of Idaho.

ARTICLE 8: Upon dissolution the assets shall be distributed:
