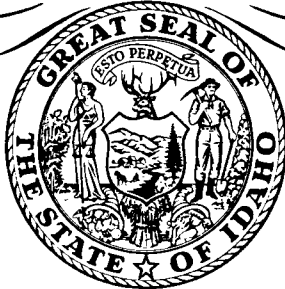

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

, 19

OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, INCORPORATED, N. Y.

WE, THE SEVERAL PERSONS WHOSE NAMES ARE HEREIN
subscribed, hereby associate ourselves into a body corporate under the
provisions of the Business Corporation Act, as contained in Chapter 1,
Title 26, State Laws Annotated, and hereinafter referred to, as being
all the powers, rights and privileges granted bodies corporate under
said act, and we do hereby state and file these Articles of Incorpora-
tion, hereby declaring and certifying that the facts stated herein are
true, to-wit:

FIRST: That the name of this corporation is:

WATERBURY LAUNDRY & DYE WORKS, INC.

SECOND: That the purposes for which this corporation is formed,
are:

(1) To carry on the business of a steam and general laundry
and to wash, clean, scrub, scour, bleach, rinse, dry, iron, color,
dye, disinfect, renovate and prepare for use, all articles of
wearing apparel, household, domestic and other linen, cotton and
woolen goods and clothing and fabrics of all kinds.

(2) To make and enter into any and all kinds of contracts,
agreements and obligations by and with any person or persons,
corporation or corporations for the purchasing, acquiring, hold-
ing, manufacturing and selling or otherwise disposing of either
as principal or agent, upon commission or otherwise, goods of all
kinds, and any article of personal property whatsoever.

(3) To make and carry out any contract, and to do any act
and exercise any power like a co-partnership or individual person

(8) To buy, purchase, or otherwise acquire, all manner of motor vehicles, machinery and equipment for the successful operation of its business, and which said corporation may deem necessary.

(9) To make and execute contracts with individuals and corporations for the utilization and efficient use of its property, and to purchase, control and use individual rights, franchises and licenses, and to make contracts for the purchase and exchange of securities.

(10) To borrow money and to execute contracts, mortgages, deeds, notes, bonds, promissory notes, certificates of indebtedness and obligations and to execute the same and to mortgage, pledge, assign or otherwise conveying and disposing of its rights, property, real or personal, tangible or intangible.

(11) To sell, lease, convey or otherwise dispose of all of the real or personal property of said corporation whenever it shall be found desirable and to use and dispose of said corporation.

(12) To pay, hold, own, or otherwise acquire, stock, bonds, or otherwise the use of shares of or certificates or bonds of this corporation; to do and perform anything as may be necessary for the carrying on of its business and not lawfully in conflict with the laws of the State of Idaho, or other to corporations.

(13) To buy, purchase, or otherwise acquire, leasehold or franchises, and to use and machinery for operating the same, together with any buildings, or other structures, establishments, and their necessary machinery and equipment, or to sell the same or any part thereof.

(34) To do such and everything necessary, advisable or proper for the accomplishment of any of the purposes or objects of any one or more of the objects herein stated, or which at any time appear conducive or expedient for the protection or benefit of the corporation.

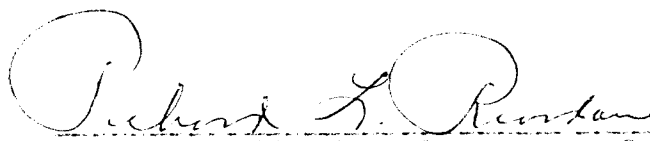
