KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned, all being citizens of the United States of America, over the age of twenty-one years, and being bons fide residents of the State of Idaho, have this day associated and do hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, and we do hereby certify:

1.

That the name of said corporation shall be the M. H. King Company.

11.

The purposes for which said corporation is formed, are:

To engage in a general mercantile business, buying and selling
for profit, merchandise of every kind and character, at both
wholesale and retail; to buy, own, lease, sell and convey or
mortgage real estate necessary, proper or convenient for the
conduct of the said business.

To purchase, rent, own, use, sell or mortgage personal property of every kind and character necessary or convenient for the carrying on of the said business.

To purchase other stores, buildings or stocks of merchandise, or to open new stores and to stock the same with merchandise, and to acquire, own, use, encumber or convey any and all property, both real and personal, necessary or convenient in conducting such store or stores wherever the same may be located, and to acquire or conduct such business and stores anywhere in the United States of America.

To borrow money or to acquire credit in any way necessary or

proper for the conduct of the said business, and to obligate the said corporation for the payment thereof, and when necessary or convenient to execute and deliver promissory notes of said corporation as evidence of such obligations, and to execute and deliver mortgages upon its real or personal property, securing such indebtedness.

To lend money, or to extend credit in any way necessary or convenient in the conduct of the said business, and to receive promissory notes or other evidence of such indebtedness, and to receive, own, hold, assign, and transfer mortgages or other security for such indebtedness.

To sue in any Court or Courts in any matter necessary or convenient for the establishment or protection of the rights of the said corporation, and to defend any and all actions brought against it.
