Amendments to the Articles of Incorporation, adopted by majority vote of the Dietrich Quick Response Unit Incorporated's membership this 31<sup>st</sup> day of March, 2006.

## Amendment #1:

No part of the net earnings of the Dietrich Quick Response Unit Incorporated, hereafter QRU, shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the QRU shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the QRU shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the organization shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, the QRU shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by and organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

### Amendment #2:

Upon the dissolution of the Dietrich Quick Response Unit Incorporated, hereafter QRU, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the QRU is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
