

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE YOUNG WOMEN'S CHRISTIAN
ASSOCIATION, OF BOISE, IDAHO.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, having this 10th
day of ~~January~~ in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred
and thirteen voluntarily associated ourselves together for the
purpose of forming a benevolent corporation of a religious
character under the laws of the State of Idaho, and hereby
certify as follows, to-wit:

-1-

That the name of the said corporation is the
"Young Women's Christian Association of Boise, Idaho"

-11-

That this corporation is formed for the following
objects and purposes to-wit:

"The purpose of this organization shall be to associate
young women in personal loyalty to Jesus Christ as Saviour and Lord;
to promote growth in Christian character and service through physi-
cal, social, mental and spiritual training; and to become a social
force for the extension of the Kingdom of God" and to acquire, hold,
own, use and dispose of in any manner all real and other property
whatsoever as may be reasonably necessary for the purpose of carry-
ing into effect any one or more of the objects hereinbefore mention-
ed, and to mortgage, sell and otherwise dispose of the same; to
borrow money, and to do all acts, and to make, execute and
deliver all needful instruments for the carrying on of said purpose
or purposes.

The principal place of business of said corporation shall be Boise, Ada County, State of Idaho.

-IV-

The time for which this corporation shall exist shall be fifty years from and after the date of its incorporation.

-V-

This corporation has no capital stock.

-VI-

That the number of directors of this corporation shall be nine.

-VII-

The Board of Directors shall have the management of the real estate of this corporation and such other management as may be prescribed by the by-laws.

-IX-

That a duly called meeting of the members of this association was held at its rooms suite No.408 in the McCarty Building, Boise, Idaho, at the corner of Ninth and Idaho Streets, on Friday the 7th day of February, A. D. 1913, at the hour of 7.30 o'clock P. M. at which meeting a majority of the members thereof were present and voted for the election of directors, and that notice of the time and place of holding such election was given by publication thereof for more than two weeks in the Idaho Weekly Statesman a newspaper published in Boise, Ada County, Idaho, in the City where said election was held, and was published in every issue thereof commencing with the 20th day of January 1913, and ending on the 3rd day of February, 1913, and also by the posting of a like notice in a conspicuous place on the building where such election was held for the same length of time immediately preceding said election, said notice being posted in said rooms of the association on the 13th day of January 1913, remaining posted thereon to and including the

7th day of February 1913. That at said meeting the following named persons were duly elected directors of this corporation and for the terms by unanimous vote of said members, as follows, to-wit: for the first year.

W. J. Abbs, W. S. Bruce, E. M. Hoover, R. L. Nourse, H. C. Wyman, Merta D. Gibson, Lulu M. Hall, Henrietta Anderson, and Martha Behle Dietrich, and that each of said persons are actual bona fide residents of Ada County, State of Idaho.

That at said meeting these Articles of Incorporation were by unanimous vote duly adopted and said persons so elected as directors were duly authorized and directed to execute and duly file the same for record and to duly incorporate this association for and on behalf of its members.
