ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
of the
JUNIOR LEAGUE of BOISE, IDAHO

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That, we, the undersigned, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho in pursuance of the purposes for which we have been elected, as hereinafter set forth, and we hereby certify:

ARTICLE 1.

That the name of this corporation is the "Junior League of Boise, Idaho."

ARTICLE 11.

The purposes and objects for which this corporation is organized are:

First. To make proper and earnest effort to aid worthy charitable organizations and persons, to promote social reform, to bring its members in touch with other organized philanthropies, to take such action as may be for the public benefit and to endeavor to find the sphere of usefulness in which the energy and capacity of each member can be applied with most efficiency.

Second. To acquire by gift, grant, purchase, devise, lease or otherwise, personal and such real property as may be necessary to promote the objects and purposes of said corporation.

Third. To sell, release, mortgage, exchange, lease or encumber any or all of its property at such times and in such manner as said corporation shall determine and

and to borrow money and issue evidences of indebtedness for the same in such form as may be deemed advisable by the corporation.

Fourth. To purchase, lease, erect, or cause to be erected a club house or club building for the use and accommodation of its members and for such other purposes as may be determined by the corporation.

Fifth. To do any and all other things or acts permitted by the laws of the State of Idaho for the purpose of carrying into effect any of the objects and purposes for which this corporation is organized.

ARTICLE III

The principal place of business of said corporation shall be Boise, County of Ada, State of Idaho.

ARTICLE IV

The term for which this corporation shall exist is fifty (50) years, from and after the date of its incorporation.

ARTICLE V.

This corporation has no capital stock.

ARTICLE VI.

There shall be nine (9) directors of this corporation from among whom shall be elected a President, a First Vice-President, a Second Vice-President, a Recording Secretary, a Corresponding Secretary, and a Treasurer.

ARTICLE VII

That at a special meeting of the said Junior League of Boise, Idaho, held at the home of Isabel Dietrich, 201 W. Jefferson Street, Boise, Idaho, on the 24th day of September, 1928 at 2 P.M. of said day, an election of nine (9) directors

was held for the ensuing year; that notice of the time, and place of holding such election was given by the publication of such notice for more than two (2) weeks in the Idaho Sunday Statesman, a newspaper published in Boise, Ada County, State of Idaho, and also by posting a like notice for the same length of time in a conspicuous place on the building where such election was held; that a majority of the members of said Junior League of Boise, Idaho, who were present at said meeting voted at said election with the result that the following named members were elected such directors:


