ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
IDAHO FALLS TECHNICAL COUNCIL, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, being of legal age and being citizens of the United States of America and residents of the State of Idaho, do hereby, as incorporators thereof, form a non-profit cooperative association under the laws of the State of Idaho, according to and in compliance with Chapter 10, Title 30, Idaho Code, and we do hereby adopt Articles of Incorporation as follows:

ARTICLE I

Name

The name of this corporation shall be the IDAHO FALLS TECHNICAL COUNCIL, INC.

ARTICLE II

Purposes

The purposes for which said corporation is formed are as follows:

1. To promote the advancement of science and engineering and to increase public knowledge and understanding of science and engineering.
2. To coordinate activities of member professional societies in the scientific and engineering fields to achieve common objectives.
3. To foster mutual understanding among member professional societies and between member societies and the public.
4. To encourage and assist in the improvement of education, vocational training and research in the science and engineering.
5. To receive by gift, bequest, devise or otherwise and to purchase, convey, mortgage and lease all kinds of real and personal property.
6. To borrow money, and to draw, make, accept, endorse, design, guarantee, execute and issue notes, checks, drafts, bonds, debentures, negotiable instruments and all other instruments for the payment of money and to mortgage or pledge its property to secure such obligations.

7. To have, exercise and enjoy all powers now or hereafter granted to corporations organized under the laws of the State of Idaho, and particularly all the powers and privileges granted to corporations under Chapter 10, Title 30, Idaho Code, and in present and future amendments thereto, and to engage in any other activity and to do any act or other thing necessary to carry into effect the aforementioned purposes.
8. To exercise and perform all of the above described powers both within and without the State of Idaho.

ARTICLE III

Principal Place of Business

This corporation shall have its principal place of business in the City of Idaho Falls, County of Bonneville, State of Idaho.

ARTICLE IV

Duration

The duration of this corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE V

Members

This corporation is organized without capital stock and the rights and interests of all the members shall be equal. The qualifications for members shall be provided in the By-laws.
