ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

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SADDLE BLANKET ENTERPRISES, INC.

know all men by these presents: That we, the undersigned, being natural persons of the age of twenty-one years or more, and citizens of the United States of America, in order to form a corporation for the purposes hereinafter stated, under and pursuant to the provisions of the Business Corporation Act, Chapter I, Title 30, of the Idaho Code, and all laws amendatory thereof, and supplemental thereto, do hereby make, subscribe, and acknowledge these Articles of Incorporation as follows:

ARTICLE I.

The name of the corporation shall be, and is, Saddle Blanket Enterprises, Inc.

ARTICLE II.

The object of this corporation and the business in which it is to be engaged are as follows:

- A. Owning, holding, leasing, managing, operating, handling, supervising, and developing public resort and recreational facilities and services, including, but not exclusively, services for boating, water skiing, camping, fishing, scenic flights, horseback riding, trap shooting, dining dancing, and all incidentals thereto in anywise related or connected; the renting, leasing, buying, selling, development and improvement of real estate in connection with said resort purposes, and the production and manufacturing of equipment or products incidental to, and used in said business.
- B. To purchase or otherwise acquire, own, hold, lease, sell, exchange, assign, transfer, mortgage or otherwise dispose of, and to invest, trade and deal in and with real property, and any and all interests therein, necessary or incident to the carrying on of any of the objects or things enumerated herein.
- C. To act as agent for any manufacturer or distributor of all kinds of personal property, and to enter into contracts with such manufacturer or distributor relative to such agency for sale or handling of such products or items as may be relative or incidental to the carrying of said business as set forth above.

- D. To acquire, hold, use, sell, assign, lease, grant licenses with respect to, mortgage or otherwise dispose of licenses, privileges, copyrights, trademarks and tradenames relating to, or useful in connection with any business of this corporation.
- E. To enter into any contracts or arrangements with any government or authority, national, state, municipal, local or otherwise, conducive to the purposes herein stated, and to obtain from any such government or authority any and all rights, privileges, grants or concessions relating to any of the objects herein stated; to carry out, exercise, comply with and enforce any such contracts, rights, privileges and concessions.
- F. To enter into, make and perform contracts of every kind and description with any person, firm, association, corporation, municipality or body politic; and to acquire, and to make payment therefor in cash or by stock or bonds of the corporation, or by undertaking or assuming the obligations and liabilities of the transferor, or in any other way, the goodwill, rights and property, the whole or any part of the assets, tangible or intangible, and to undertake or assume the liabilities of, any person, firm, association or corporation, to hold or in any manner dispose of the whole or any part of the property so purchased; to conduct in any lawful manner the whole or any part of the business so acquired and to exercise all of the powers necessary or convenient for the conduct and management thereof.
- G. To borrow or raise money for any of the purposes of the corporation, without limit as to amount, and in connection therewith, to grant collateral or other security either alone or jointly with any other person, firm or corporation and to make, execute, draw, accept, endorse, discount, pledge, issue, sell or otherwise dispose of promissory notes, drafts, bills of exchange, warrants, bonds, debentures and other evidences of indebtedness, negotiable or non-negotiable, transferable or non-transferable, and to confer upon the holders of any of its obligations such powers, rights and privileges as from time to time may be deemed advisable by the board of directors, to the extent permitted under the laws of the State of Idaho; to lend and advance money, extend credit, take notes, open accounts and every kind and nature of evidence of indebtedness and collateral security in connection therewith.
- H. To have one or more offices, and to carry on the business of the corporation without restriction in any lawful manner; to have, exercise and enjoy all powers now or hereafter granted to corporations organized under the laws of the State of Idaho, and particularly all of the powers and privileges granted to corporations by Chapter 1, Title 30, Idaho Code, and present and/or future amendments thereto, and to do any act or other thing necessary or convenient for the transaction of the aforesaid business and/or carrying into effect any and all of the aforesaid objects and purposes.
- I. To exercise and perform any and all of the hereinabove mentioned and described powers, both within and without the State of Idaho.

ARTICLE III.

That the duration of said corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE IV.

That the location and post office address of the registered office of said corporation in Idaho shall be in Pocatello, Bannock County, Idaho.

ARTICLE V.

That the shares of stock of said corporation are not to be classified and shall all be common stock, and that the authorized shares of said corporation shall be One Thousand in number, of the par value of Twenty-five and no/100 Dollars (\$25.00) each, and of the aggregate par value of Twenty-five Thousand and no/100 Dollars (\$25,000.00). That the said shares of stock shall be fully paid up before being issued and after issuance shall be non-assessable.

ARTICLE VI.
