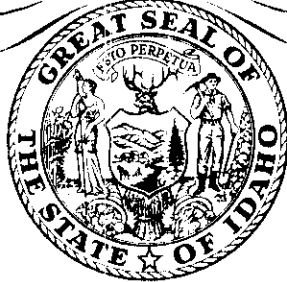

CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

I, ARNOLD WILLIAMS, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

COEUR D'ALENE AERIE NO. 485 FRATERNAL ORDER OF EAGLES, INC.

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **Nineteenth** day of **January,** A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **Sixty-two** and is duly recorded on Film No. **114** of Record of Domestic Corporations of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Sections 30-103, 30-1101 and 30-1102, Idaho Code.

AND I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name stated in the articles, and for **perpetual existence** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at **Coeur d'Alene** in the County of **Kootenai** and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Religious, Ex-Service Men, Benevolent, Charitable and Fraternal Corporations, as provided in Chapter 11, Title 30, Idaho Code.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF CLAUDE WILSON Aerie No. 186
FRATERNAL ORDER OF EAGLES, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned, all being of legal age and citizens of the United States of America, this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporate, non-profit, cooperative fraternal association under and pursuant to the laws of the State of Idaho generally, and particularly on pursuant to Chapter 11, Title 70, of the Idaho Code Annotated, and we do hereby certify:

NAME: The name of the Corporation shall be Claude Wilson Aerie No. 186
FRATERNAL ORDER OF EAGLES, INC.

PURPOSE: The purpose for which this corporation is formed is to give corporate existence to the members of a Fraternal Lodge association known as Claude Wilson Aerie No. 186, Fraternal Order of Eagles, for the purpose of operating a club and social or lodge room; to purchase, take, hold, lease, rent, sell or mortgage real property for the purpose of owning or operating a social club or lodge rooms; to purchase, take, hold, lease, rent, sell or mortgage personal property for the purpose of owning or operating a social club or lodge rooms, and to do all things incidental, necessary or convenient in the carrying out of the foregoing purposes. It is no part of the purpose of this corporation to have any part whatever in the exercise of the powers granted to said Claude Wilson Aerie No. 186, by the Grand Aerie, Fraternal Order of Eagles, or by the Fraternal System known in the aggregate as the Fraternal Order of Eagles, to operate a secret society or lodge under the laws and rituals of the said Fraternal Order of Eagles. The purpose of the corporation is to exercise property rights with reference to a social club or lodge rooms.

MEMBERSHIP of said corporation shall consist only of the members in good standing of said Fraternal Lodge association known as Claude Wilson Aerie No. 186, Fraternal Order of Eagles and none other. Acquisition of membership in the said Fraternal Lodge association must be Claude Wilson Aerie No. 186, Fraternal Order of Eagles, shall carry with it also access thereto in this corporation. There shall be no other way or means of becoming a member of this corporation. Membership in this corporation shall cease whenever membership ceases in the said Fraternal association known as Claude Wilson Aerie No. 186, Fraternal Order of Eagles, and the acquiring of any right which will bring about the acquisition of membership in the said

fraternal lodge association, known as Grand Alliance, No. 486,
Fraternal Order of Eagles shall give preference of membership in
this corporation, and the dissolution for any cause of the said
fraternal lodge association as a fraternal lodge of that grade of lodges
known in the degree to be of the Grand Order of Eagles, shall forthwith
work a dissolution of this corporation, and in such event, the affairs of
this corporation shall be wound up in accordance with the laws
of this state.

NOTE: This corporation shall have no capital structure.

RESISTANCE OFFICE: A. Beattie and post office address of A. Beattie, principal office in this state and the principal place of business shall be Beattie, Illinois, Rockland County, Idaho.

MEMBERSHIP CERTIFICATE. This is a record of all of issue my original stock, but shall issue a new one in place of the one lost hereof, which certificate shall be thereunto certified by the Secretary of the Board of Directors of the company, and which shall be issued to each member of the company as described by said Board of Directors, in the Order of the Board of Directors.

NON-PROFIT. No dividends of any kind or nature shall ever be declared to any member of this corporation, and no member shall ever receive any pecuniary profit from his membership in this corporation, it being expressly understood that this shall be a strictly non-profit corporation.

XX-1001. The type of this designation shall be those established by the Grand Juris, Federal Order of Eagles, for the members of individual lodges and shall be changed only in accordance with such changes as shall from time to time be made by said Grand Juris, Federal Order of Eagles.

ARTICLE IV. The annual meeting of the Association of the Corporation for the election of Directors and for such other business as may be lawfully conducted shall be held on the first meeting day of May of each year. Said director shall serve a term of one year, or June 1, of each year.
