





#### Resolution

A resolution by the Board of Trustees of Preston Village declaring such village to be a city of the second class and changing the corporate name thereof.

Be it resolved by the chairman and Board of Trustees of Preston village Oneida County Idaho.

That whereas said village of Preston contains more than one thousand inhabitants and whereas a number of the qualified electors of said village equal to three fifths of the total vote as shown by the last preceding general election of said village have petitioned said Board of village trustees to forth with pass and publish a resolution declaring Preston Village a City of the second class and changing the corporate name of said village to City of Preston.

Now therefore it is hereby resolved that the village of Preston is a city of the second class and the corporate name of said village is changed from the village of Preston to City of Preston. Passed February 6th, 1912. J. N. Larsen,
