7	We, the undersigned citizens of the State of Idaho have this day voluntarily				
8	associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a non-profit corporation				
9	under and pursuant to Title 30, Chapter 3, Idaho Code, and we do hereby certify				
10	ARTICLE I				
11	The name of this corporation is DOWNTOWN LEWISTON PROPERTY OWNERS				
12	ASSOCIATION, INC. A/K/A DOWNTOWN LEWISTON PROGRESSIVE MERCHANTS.				
13	ARTICLE II				
14	This corporation shall have perpetual duration.				
15	ARTICLE III				
16	The purposes and objects for which this corporation is formed are as follows:				
17	1. To form a non-profit corporation for the protection and service of and to				
18	the individual members of the association and to further their common interests.				
19	2. To preserve, protect and encourage private ownership of property and				
20	to actively engage in promoting and protecting the rights of private property				
21	owners within Downtown Lewiston, Nez Perce County, State of Idaho.				
22	3. To take whatever action is necessary to protect the members of the				
23	association from arbitrary of discriminatory taxation and from excessive and				
24	unnecessary expenditures of public tax revenue.				
25	ARTICLE IV				
26	The corporation shall have the following powers:				
27	1. To sue and be sued before competent tribunals at the will of the directors				
28	or membership.				
29	2. To own, buy, sell, lease, assign, mortgage, hypothecate and by all lawful				
30	acts, deal in real and personal property, including the erection and maintenance of				
31	buildings and the obtaining of personal property which would further the interests				
32	of the corporation.				

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- 3. To extablish bank accounts, charge dues and fees, solicit money, engage in non-profit enterprises, raise money, hire and fire employees, make loans, acquire loans, deal in choses of action, and engage in any enterprise connected to the purposes herein established in any lawful way, so long as the same are a non-profit nature.
- 4. To issue bonds, notes and other instruments of debt and to deal in the stocks, bonds, notes, mortgages and debt instruments of any other person, firm or corporation.
- 5. To join or merge with any other group, firm, association or corporation, non-profit in nature, whose purposes are not in conflict with those herein stated.

### ARTICLE V

This shall be a member ship corporation. The membership fees and conditions shall be established by the By-Laws.

#### ARTICLE VI

The location and post office of the registered office of the corporation is Paulucci's Tailor & Men's Wear, 520 Main Street, Lewiston, Idaho 83501 U.S.A.

The name of the registered agent is Mr. Giacobbe "Jack" Paulucci.

#### ARTICLE VII
