ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

IDAHO STATE INVESTORS, INC.

(A Non-profit Cooperative Association)

We, the undersigned, incorporators, being natural persons of lawful age, and citizens of the United States, do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation, and hereby associate ourselves together to form and establish a corporation not for profit, but under the provisions of Chapter 10 of the Idaho Code governing the formation of corporations, and more particularly governing the formation of a Non-profit Cooperative Association:

Article I

The name of this non-profit cooperative association shall be IDAHO STATE INVESTORS, INC.

Article II

The period of its duration is to be perpetual.

Article III

The location and post office address of its registered office in the State of Idaho shall be the office of the Dean of the College of Business Administration, Idaho State University, Pocatello, Idaho.

Article IV

The corporation shall not have authority to issue any capital stock, but shall issue membership certificates to the members of said corporation, which certificates may not be assigned so that the transferee thereof can by such transfer become a member of the association, except by resolution of the Board of Directors, and under such regulations as the By-laws may prescribe.

Article V

The purpose for which this corporation is formed is NOT for profit, and the objects and purposes are not, in any manner, to make a profit for the individual members of the corporation or

- (A) To pursue educational and benevolent goals, and to enhance and increase the knowledge of the members concerning the capital markets of the American economy.
- (B) To study and to invest in any and all forms and kinds of negotiable securities; to buy and to sell the same.
- (C) To acquire by purchase, lease, exchange or otherwise, land, buildings, fixtures, or hereditaments of any tenure or description situated in the State of Idaho; and to manage the same and turn the same to account as the same may be expedient and proper, with regard to the corporate purposes herein recited.
- (D) To establish, operate and fund scholarships to be established at the educational institution under which the individual branch or corporation operates, at such time as the annual income from dividends and net gain on sales of securities, or other income reach a level to be designated and set by the By-laws of this corporation.
- (E) To make no profit for the individual members of the club, but with a view, rather, to operate and conduct an organization committed to the education of its members and for other benevolent purposes relating to scholarships and other services, as contemplated by these articles.
- (F) To issue and control membership certificates, and to conduct any and all business reasonably related to the operation of a corporation or society formed for non-profit and benevolent purposes.

Article VI

The private property of the members of this corporation shall not be liable for its corporate debts.

Article VII

The rights and interests of all members shall be equal, and as provided in Section 30-1004 of the Idaho Code. No member may have or acquire a greater interest therein than any other member.

Article VIII

The number of directors of this corporation shall be not less than five (5) nor more than nine (9), and the names and addresses of the first Board of Directors are as follows, to-wit:
