ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF  
RICE MICROTEC, INC.

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of a corporation under the Idaho Business Corporation Act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

FIRST: The name of the corporation is Rice Microtec, Inc.

SECOND: The period of its duration is perpetual.

THIRD: The purpose for which the corporation is organized is the transaction of any or all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the Idaho Business Corporation Act.

FOURTH: The corporation shall have authority to issue 1,000,000 shares of common stock, all of one class, with no par value.
