FIRST.

SECOND.

That the purposes for which this corporation is formed are, to operate and maintain a factory for the purpose of manufacturing both butter and cheese, or either of them, from whole milk, and to perform all acts necessary to accomplish the same, or to market and sell such products, and to buy and sell both real and personal --- property.

THIRD.

That the place where its principal business shall be trans---acted shall be in the town of Salubria, County of Washington, State of Idaho,

FOURTH.
