ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

MEXICO-PACIFIC MINING CO., INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS That we, Patrick M. Tabor, Carole Tabor, and G. R. Kneeland, all of who are of legal age and citizens of the United States of America, do hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of incorporation, and hereby incorporate under and conformable to the laws of the State of Idaho, and do hereby make, execute, adopt and publish and certify the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I.

The name of this corporation shall be:

MEXICO-PACIFIC MINING CO., INC.

ARTICLE II.

It shall be the purpose of this corporation to search for ores and minerals, to mine, mill or otherwise process ores and minerals, to grant licenses for mining in or over any land which may be acquired by the company; to discover and locate mining properties of all kinds; to prospect; to enter into agreements for the discovery of mining properties, and generally, to engage in any form of mining activities involving mining property not contrary to law; to generally carry on any other lawful business whatsoever which is calculated, directly or indirectly, to promote the interests of the corporation or to enhance the value of its properties.

ARTICLE III.

The duration of the existence of this corporation shall be perpetual.
