To the Secretary of State of the State of Idaho

Pursuant to Title 30, Chapter 3, Idaho Code, the undersigned non-profit corporation amends its articles of incorporation as follows:

STATE OF IDAHO

 1. The name of the corporation is: Friends Church of Boise

2. The text of each amendment is as follows:

Add to end of Article 2: "and to conduct church affairs as set forth in the Northwest Yearly Meeting of Friends Churches, Faith and Practice, a book of Christian Discipline."

Add the following articles:

IV. "The method of electing trustees and the duties of the trustees shall be in accord with the said Faith and Practice of the Northwest Yearly Meeting of Friends Church."

V. "Though intended to be perpetual, the corporation, in case of dissolution, provides that the assets shall become the property of Northwest Yearly Meeting of Friends Church or its successors."

VI. "Every person who has been admitted as a member of Boise Friends Church in accordance with the said Faith and Practice shall be a member of this corporation, and no other terms of admission into such corporation will be recognized or required."

Articles of Incorporation  
Friends Church of Boise

KNOW ALL MEN:

That we, the undersigned, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of incorporating under the laws of the State of Idaho, and in pursuance of the purposes for which we have been elected, as hereinafter set forth, a religious corporation to be known as Friends Church of Boise.

And we certify:

- I. The name assumed by this corporation, and by which it shall be known, is:  
Friends Church of Boise.
- II. The object for which this corporation is formed, is –  
To establish a Church in the City of Boise, in the County of Ada and State of Idaho for the benefit of religion, for works of charity, and for public worship, and in connection therewith, its suitable and customary organizations, such as Sabbath Schools, Christian Endeavors, and so forth – To take charge of the Church and Church Parsonage, and all and singular, the estate, property, and the affairs of the temporalities thereof – and to acquire, hold, lease, contract, sell, convey and dispose of said property, or any part thereof, and to conduct church affairs as set forth in the Northwest Yearly Meeting of Friends Churches, Faith and Practice, a book of Christian Discipline.
- III. The estimated value of the property at the time of making these articles of incorporation is two thousand dollars.
- IV. The method of electing trustees and the duties of the trustees shall be in accord with the said Faith and Practice of Northwest Yearly Meeting of Friends Church.
- V. Though intended to be perpetual, the corporation, in case of dissolution, provides that the assets shall become the property of Northwest Yearly Meeting of Friends Church or its successors.
- VI. Every person who has been admitted as a member of Boise Friends Church in accordance with the said Faith and Practice shall be a member of this corporation, and no other terms of admission into such corporation will be recognized or required.
