

DESIGNATION OF AGENT AND ACCEPTANCE OF PROVISIONS  
OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE OF IDAHO.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That CURTIS & YALE COMPANY, a corporation, organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Iowa and doing business at Wausau, Marathon County, Wisconsin, having filed in the office of the Secretary of State of Idaho a duly authenticated copy of its Articles of Incorporation, does hereby, in pursuance of the laws of the State of Idaho, make this certificate, and does hereby designate Kootenai County, in the State of Idaho, as the County in which the principal place of business of said corporation in the State of Idaho is and shall be conducted, and does hereby designate R. M. HART, residing at Coeur d'Alene in said Kootenai Co., as the authorized agent of said corporation in said State of Idaho, upon whom process issued by authority of, or under any law of the State of Idaho, may be served as provided by the Constitution and laws of the State of Idaho.

And the said Curtis & Yale Company, desiring and intending to conform in all respects to the Constitution and laws of said State, and to avail itself of the rights, privileges and immunities guaranteed by said Constitution and laws, does hereby accept the provisions of the Constitution of the State of Idaho, for all the intents and purposes contemplated by the provisions thereof, relating to such acceptance by other than municipal corporations. (Article XI, Section 7, Constitution of Idaho.).
