ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

MERIDIAN CAB CO., INC.

The undersigned, acting as incorporators of a corporation under the Idaho Business Corporation Act, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

FIRST: The name of the corporation is MERIDIAN CAB CO., INC..

SECOND: The period of its duration is perpetual.

THIRD: The purpose for which the corporation is organized is the transaction of any and all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the Idaho Business Corporation Act.

FOURTH: The aggregate number of shares which the corporation shall have authority to issue is Five Thousand (5,000) shares, with a par value of \$1.00 per share, and all shares are to be of one class.
