Articles of Incorporation  
of the  
Blackfoot Irrigation Company.

We, whose names are hereto subscribed, desiring to organize and form a Corporation under and pursuant to the laws of the Territory of Idaho, do hereby associate together for the purpose hereinafter mentioned and agree to make, publish, declare and certify the following articles of Incorporation:

Article 1.

The name of this Corporation shall be The Blackfoot Irrigating Company.

Article 2.

This Corporation is formed for the purpose of acquiring and conducting and distributing a portion of the waters of Snake River for agricultural purposes upon certain lands lying along and in an easterly and southerly direction, from said river, in the County of Bingham, Territory of Idaho.

Article 3.

The principal place of Business, Office or Headquarters of the said Company shall be at Blackfoot, Bingham County

## Article, 5.

The Corporate powers, business and property of this Corporation shall be exercised, conducted and controlled by a board of seven directors or Trustees to be elected from among the holders of its stock at each annual meeting of stockholders as provided in the by-laws of the Corporation but for the present and until their successors shall be duly elected, the following named persons, with their residences, as follows, viz:

Presley B. Fox Blackfoot, Bingham County, Idaho  
Samuel Lloyd Blackfoot, Bingham, County, Idaho  
William Howard Blackfoot Bingham County, Idaho  
John M. Sheridan Blackfoot Bingham County, Idaho  
John P. Mellen Blackfoot Bingham, County, Idaho  
Robert M. Shannon Blackfoot Bingham County, Idaho  
are hereby declared to constitute the Board of Directors or Trustees with full power to fill vacancies and manage the affairs and business of said Corporation, and for the present and until their successors are appointed and qualified, George A. Robertson shall be president - John P. Mellen shall

Dollars, divided into Three hundred shares at fifty dollars each, which Capital stock has been taken, as follows:

### Article 7.

Subordinate officers may from time to time be appointed, having such powers not inconsistent with these articles, and the act under which these articles are drawn and in such manner as may be provided by resolution or by the by laws of the Corporation.
