ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

RAYMOND CREEK IRRIGATION COMPANY STA

SECRETARY OF The undersigned, acting as incorporators of a corporation under the Idaho Non-profit Corporation Act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

The name of the corporation is RAYMOND CREEK FIRST: IRRIGATION COMPANY.

SECOND: The period of duration of this non-profit corporation is perpetual.

> THIRD: This is a non-profit corporation.

The purpose or purposes for which the corpora-FOURTH: tion is organized are:

> To own, acquire, hold, manage, control, operate and maintain that certain pipeline and irrigation system now under construction; also, to acquire the water rights taken up for the irrigation of the lands under said irrigation system, and to acquire other water rights in case the same may be deemed desirable; to acquire, hold, own, maintain and control the water from Raymond Creek, tributary of Thomas Fork, tributary of Bear River, or other sources of supply; to fix, charge and collect from its stockholders tolls, rentals, assessments and maintenance charges based upon the number of shares of stock held by each person or proportioned to the amount of water used or owned or by both of said methods or by assessment upon the capital stock levied in accordance with the laws of Idaho, or by such other method as may be prescribed in the bylaws of said corporation; to construct, operate and maintain pipelines, canals, ditches and reservoirs, and generally to do any and all things necessary or proper to be done in conducting the business of supplying its

stockholders with water for irrigation and domestic use and other useful and beneficial purposes.

FIFTH: The aggregate number of shares which the corporation shall have authority to issue is <u>1500</u> shares without par value.

SIXTH: All shares of this corporation are assessable for the purpose of paying expenses, conducting business or paying debts, and the corporation shall have the power to levy and collect assessments upon such shares in the manner and form and to the extent provided by law. Each certificate of stock issued by the corporation shall have a provision for assessment noted conspicuously on the face thereof.

SEVENTH: The address of the initial registered office of the corporation is Raymond Route, Geneva, Idaho, and the name of its initial registered agent at such address is Kenneth Rigby.

EIGHTH: The number of directors constituting the initial board of directors of the corporation is five (5), and the names and addresses of the persons who are to serve as directors until the first annual meeting of shareholders or until their successors are elected and shall qualify are:
