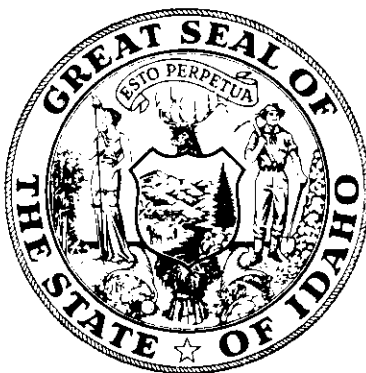

4. All debts, obligations, and liabilities of the corporation have been paid and discharged.


5. All remaining property of the corporation has been distributed among the shareholders in proportion to their respective rights and interests.




