

know all Men by These Presents: That the undersigned, being a natural citizen of full age and a citizen of the United States of America, in order to form a corporation for the purposes hereinafter stated, under and pursuant to the provisions of the general laws of the State of Idaho, does hereby certify as follows:

# ARTICLE I

The name of the Corporation shall be RAMSEYER FARMS,

#### ARTICLE II

The Corporation's purposes are: To carry on any business whatsoever that this corporation may deem proper or convenient in connection with any business purpose or otherwise, or that it may deem calculated, directly or indirectly, to improve the interests of this corporation, and to have and to exercise all powers conferred by the laws of the State of Idaho on corporations formed under the laws pursuant to which and under the laws pursuant to which and

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any time hereafter be amended, and to do any and all things hereinabove set forth to the same extent and as fully as natural persons might or could do, either alone or in connection with other persons, firms, associations or corporations, and in any part of the world.

#### ARTICLE III

The Corporation is to have perpetual existence.

#### ARTICLE IV
