

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

THUNDER MOUNTAIN TRUST AND DEVELOPMENT COMPANY (Limited).

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KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho.

AND WE HEREBY CERTIFY:

FIRST: That the name of said corporation is Thunder Mountain Trust and Development Company (Limited).

SECOND: That the purposes for which it is formed are, To locate, acquire, lease, buy and sell water powers and mill sites. To erect dams, generate electric or other power and use and dispose of the same for all purposes. To erect mills, crushers and plants of all kinds for the purpose of separating metal from ores, ^{and} to erect mills for the manufacture of lumber and other commodities. To locate town sites and to dispose of the same in lots or otherwise, and to improve the same. To locate, enter, buy, sell, lease and dispose of mines and mining property, to operate mines and appurtenances. To buy, sell and exchange real estate and personal property, including notes, bonds, mortgages and other securities. To act as agents for persons, corporations and companies in all lines of business. To act as fiscal and receiving agents. To organize and dispose of mining syndicates and companies and mining properties for itself and others. To do a general transportation and forwarding business. To organize and finance business propositions of all kinds. To conduct a general banking and trust company business, and to make and furnish abstracts of title.

THIRD: That the place where its principal business is to be transacted shall be Salmon, in the State of Idaho.

FOURTH: That the term for which it is to exist is fifty years from and after the date of its incorporation.

FIFTH: That the number of directors shall be five, and that the names and residences of those who are appointed for the first year are :

SIXTH: That the amount of ^{the} capital stock of this corporation shall be One Hundred Thousand Dollars, divided into one thousand shares of one hundred dollars each.
