First Church of Christ (Christian), Incorporated Ammendment to Articles of Incorporation

April 6, 1977

This amendment being duly considered and presented by the terms indicated in the Constitution and By-laws of the First Church of Christ (Christian), Incorporated are to become adopted as a part of the Articles of Incorporation by ratification of the majority as called for in the present By-laws.

There is to be added to the Constitution and By-laws the following three (3) paragraphs which set out the purposes of the Church in conforming with the Internal Revenue Code Section 501 (C) (3) dealing with tax exempt organizations.

The additions are as follows:

This corporation is organized exclusively for religious, charitable, scientific, literary, or educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501 (C)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by the organization exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Upon the winding up and dissolution of the corporation, after paying or adequately providing for the debts and obligations of the organization, the remaining assets shall be distributed to a non-profit fund, foundation or corporation which as established its tax exempt status under Section 501 (C)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
